3-D Mirror Nail Art

Entry fee: \$75.00 (post marked) July 2, 2010 on site \$100.00

Briefing: 12:45 – 1:00 pm

Competition: 1:00 – 4:00 pm
Judging: 4:05 pm

3-D Mirror Nail Art

1. The left hand must be completed prior to the competition.
2. Only the model & competitor are allowed in the competition floor.
3. Competitors and Models must be 18 yrs of age or older
4. Models must be pre-manicured & ready for enhancement.
5. Art theme must be followed on all 10 nails.
6. All nail art must be made from professional nail products (colored liquid and powder acrylic, light cured gel wraps and resin, polish, rhinestones, etc).
7. Embellishments or adornments may be used, but must NOT exceed 25% of the overall design.
8. Top coat, UV gel sealant or glitter polish may be used.
9. Competitors may NOT use any copyrighted art, designs or logos.
10. No nail pre-application allowed, all application of the design components must be done during the 3 hours provided.
11. Competitors must prepare and submit a written statement in two parts. One detailing the products and processes used to create the art and one telling the story of your interpretation of the theme. Do NOT name the specific brands or manufactures, and DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME. Failure to provide this information will result in a 5-point deduction in overall score.

**Award: First Place \$125.00 & Trophy, Second Place \$100.00 & Award
Third Place \$75.00 Awards will commence at 5:00 on stage**

At the discretion of the competition committee there must be at least 6 competitors for cash awards, but other awards will be presented. All competitors will receive Certificate of Participation.

INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL COMPETITION

PINK & WHITE NAILS

Sculptured Nails will be judged in the following 10 categories: smile lines, C-curves, cuticle area, shape, product control(moons), surface structure, lateral structure, length, polish application & finishing work & overall impression.

Date: July 12, 2010 Monday
Entry fee: \$50.00 (post marked) July 2, 2010 on site \$75.00
Registration: 10:00 – 11:00 am
Briefing: 1:45 – 2:00 pm

Competition: 2:00 – 3:30 pm
Judging: 3:35 pm

Rules

Competitors must use liquid-and-powder sheer pink, clear and white acrylic products or light-cured gel products only to create the sculptured nails.

The nail enhancements on the one hand (competitor's choice) must be polished with red cream polish. The nail enhancements on the unpolished hand must be French-style (pink/clear or white), finished to a high shine and completely free of polish. The underside of both hands must look the same.

All smile lines must be done with a brush by hand. Moons must be included at the base of the nail on the unpolished hand. At the discretion of the competitor, moons may be added to the polished hand.

The model's natural nails may be prepared for product application before the competition, but product may NOT be applied until the competition starts. Make sure you inspect your model's natural nails before the competition to verify there is no damage that could affect the overall finished look.

Only water may be used to remove dust. All materials used in the competition including files and buffers must be clean and unused.

You May NOT USE

Tips and adhesives.

Enhancement products containing glitter or any other color.

No embellishments may be added to the nail.

Inverted tips or accessories for assisting in making the smile line

Electric files, chamois buffers or buffing products

No canned air, cleansing products like soap or moisturizing products can be used.

Base coat, ridge filler or top coat.
